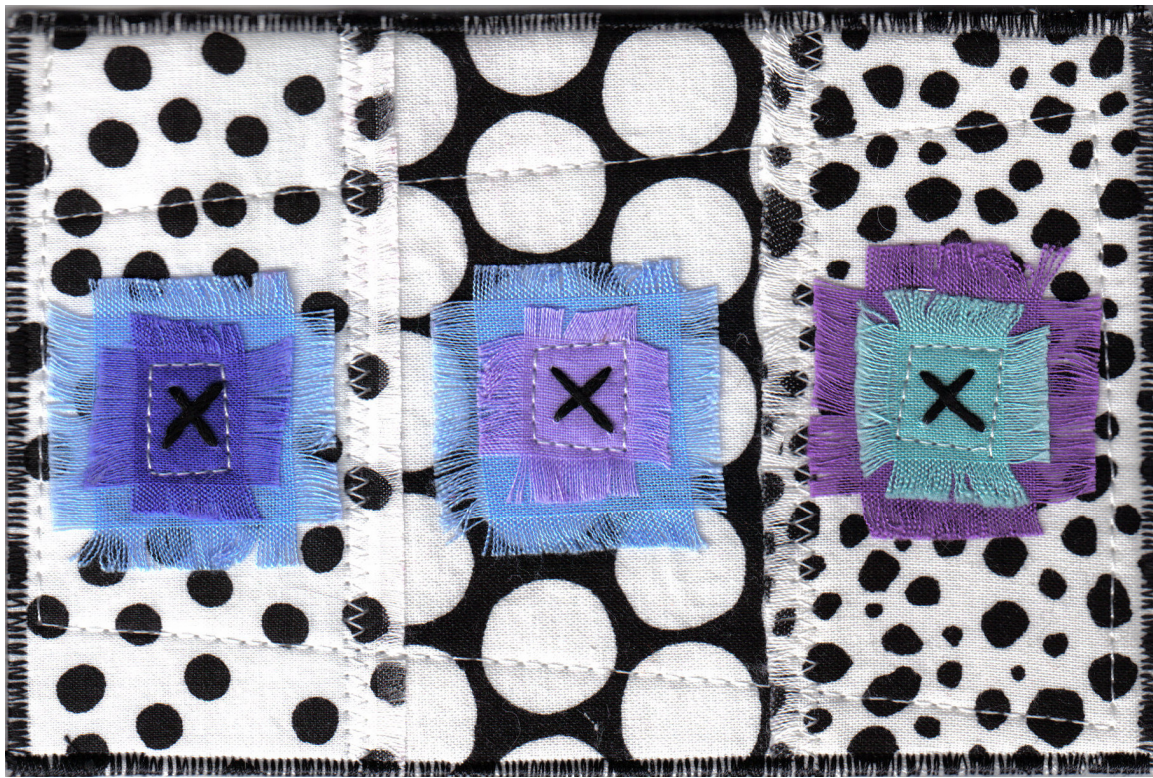

Squared Up Fabric Postcard Pattern

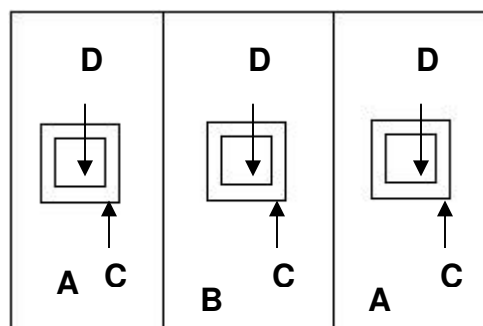

To Create the Squared Up Fabric Postcard:

1. Cut out the fabric pieces:
 - A. CUT 2: Piece A, 2 ¼" W x 4 ¼" H, Black and White Prints
 - B. CUT 1: Piece B, 2 ½" W x 4 ¼" H, Black and White Print
 - C. CUT 3: Piece C, 1 ½" W x 1 ½" H, Several Colors of Solid Fabrics
 - D. CUT 3: Piece D, 1" W x 1" H, Several Colors of Solid Fabrics
2. Fray the edges of Pieces C and D on all 4 edges by gently pulling off threads. I frayed them about 1/8" to ¼" on my piece.
3. Fray only one of the (long) 4 ¼" sides of Pieces A.
4. Place Piece B on the center third of the postcard. Place Pieces A on top of Piece B with the straight edges aligned with the right and left sides of the postcard. The frayed edges towards the center of the postcard as shown in the photo. Iron all 3 pieces to the fusible side of the Peltex.
5. Place a Piece D on top of a Piece C in each third of the postcard on the center horizontal line and move them around until you like your color arrangement. Using an UHU glue stick, lightly tack pieces D and C in place.
6. Hand or machine stitch the "X" motif in the center of each set of squares. I used 6 strands of black embroidery floss and hand stitched them.
7. Trim the edges back to your 4" x 6" postcard size with your rotary cutter.
8. Continue to quilt on the postcard either by hand or machine. Embellish, attach the back, finish the edges and go!

CUT 2: Piece A, 2 ¼" W x 4 ¼" H
CUT 1: Piece B, 2 ½" W x 4 ¼" H
CUT 3: Piece C, 1 ½" W x 1 ½" H
CUT 3: Piece D, 1" W x 1" H
